
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#### M.Ed. Curriculum and Instruction Program





#### Ph.D. Educational Administration and Leadership Program

The PhD EAL program has three types and two tracks. All types may be completed in three years. Type 1.1 is the dissertation-only track, and students must complete 54 credits. \*This track is open only to experienced educational administrators and is subject to committee evaluation and approval. Type 2.1 Track 1 is coursework and dissertation; students must complete 54 credits. Type 2.1 Track II is coursework and dissertation, and graduates are eligible to apply for the administrative license from the Thai Teachers Council. *Only Thai nationals may apply*. Students must complete 60 credits.
